PRE-SURGERY INSTRUCTIONS

You must stop the following medications **7 days before** surgery:

- · Aspirin, BC or Goody's Powders
- Ibuprofen (Advil or Motrin)
- Naproxen/Naprosyn (Aleve)
- Excedrin
- ALL NSAIDS
- Vitamin E
- Fish Oil/Flaxseed Oil
- Herbal Supplements (list furnished upon request)

You may use Tylenol/Acetaminophen for pain/fever relief.

Please notify our office if you take the following prescriptions: There are separate instructions for stopping the following medications:

- · Coumadin, Plavix, Eliquis, Xarelto, Warfarin etc.
- Weight Loss Injection / Diabetic Injection (Wegovy, Ozempic, Mounjaro, Zepbound etc.)
- Arthritis medications (Celebrex, Mobic, Voltaren, etc...)

STOP all food and drink at <u>Midnight the night before surgery</u>- this includes water, gum, candy and medication! You cannot have anything past midnight the night before surgery or anything the morning of your surgery.

Billing, Insurance and Cancellation

- Billing and Insurance- Our billing dept will verify benefits in regards to the physician fees and send a statement
 to you prior to surgery. We will also obtain prior notification and/or pre-cert if required by your insurance company.
 Please call our billing dept at for any billing questions. Any charges associated with the facility, anesthesia, lab
 and/or pathology are in addition to our fees and will be addressed by those companies.
- Cancellation- We require at least a one-week notice for surgery cancellations and re-schedules. All surgeries
 cancelled less than 7 days prior to surgery can incur a \$250.00 late cancellation fee. The fee automatically
 applies if you do not show up for surgery.
- Nasal/sinus surgery patients will have post-operative nasal debridements with the physician. Based on your healing, you may be subject to 1-4 debridements in the physician's office. Your insurance company may consider debridements as surgical procedures which may be subject to co-pays and deductibles.

Additional Information

- Prescription narcotic pain medications are not refilled on weekends. If you feel that you may run out,
 please call our office no later than 3pm on Fridays to request a refill.
- **FMLA/Surgery related paperwork** There is a fee for this service. You must obtain this paperwork from your employer and allow us <u>one week</u> to complete. Paperwork will not be filled out until the fee is paid.
